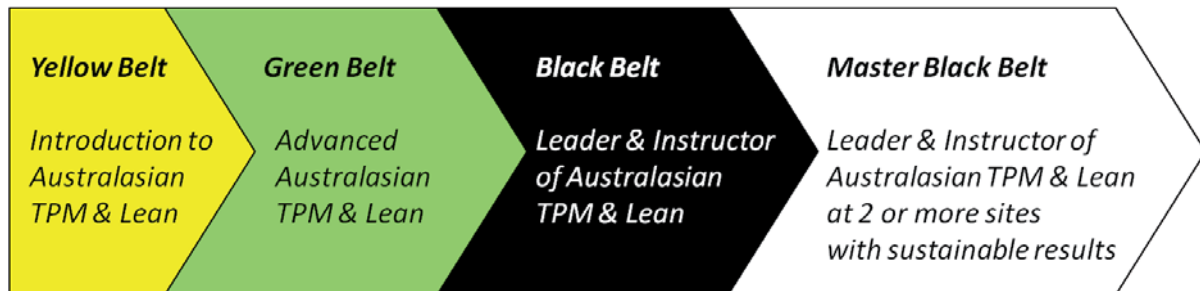

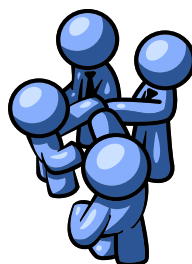
Skill to handle the sensitive nature of 'pull' change within the workplace as opposed to our more traditional 'push' approach to improvement
