About Smart and Skilled

Smart and Skilled is a reform of the NSW Vocational Education and Training (VET) system. It's helping people in NSW get the skills they need to find a job and advance their careers. Training Services NSW in the NSW Department of Education is responsible for Smart and Skilled and leads policy, planning, funding, regulation and advice on VET and employment in NSW.

About CTPM

CTPM has been assisting companies since 1996 to engage their people to envisage and strive for Operational Excellence. Since January 2016, CTPM has been offered and has accepted a Smart and Skilled contract to be an approved training provider for the NSW Department of Industry to deliver the Smart and Skilled Targeted Priorities Prevocational and Part Qualification Program which is fully subsidised by the NSW Government.

CTPM then links this training to strategically driven team based improvement activities typically based on a 12 week improvement cycle of 1.0 – 1.5 hr per week team meetings. Overall, the funding covers some 80% - 90% of the total cost.

Who qualifies to receive this subsidised training?

Any personnel who are, living or working in New South Wales; aged 15 years and older; no longer in secondary education; and either an Australian Citizen, a permanent Australian resident, a humanitarian visa holder, or a New Zealand Citizen.

The funding is available no matter what other qualifications they have previously achieved.
